Participants will have:-

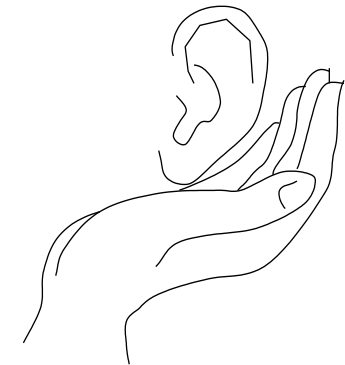
- a. revised the basic anatomy and physiology of the ear
